

# PROMOTING SMART ENERGY POLICY AND PUTTING DATA TO WORK

#### What is community solar?

- 1. Solar panels are installed in a sunny location somewhere in the community.
- 2. Anyone with an electricity bill can subscribe to this community solar array and start accessing solar energy for their home.
- 3. Each subscriber is credited with the electricity created by their share of the solar array right on their electric bill, regardless of where they live.



In addition to supporting the Illinois Clean Jobs coalition, we utilized our data and mapping expertise to help Cook County and the U.S. Department of Energy assess the opportunity for community solar in Illinois.

### ENERGY COST DISCLOSURE PAYS OFF


In a first-of-its-kind analysis, we looked at 18 months of data since the City of Chicago passed a modernized energy cost disclosure ordinance and found that Chicago homes that disclose energy costs have a higher close rate and spend less time on the market.
